



## Uniform Code

PBC is a uniform school. All PBC students are expected to accept and support these standards of dress as determined by the Executive Principal and supported by the PBC P&C. This policy is an integral part of our school security program and supports the QLD Department of Education, Workplace Health and Safety Policy. Students are required to wear the complete school uniform each day and students should present to school in a “fresh, neat and tidy” uniform at all times. This standard will ensure that PBC maintains its fine reputation in the community and enhances our public image.

Students are able to wear their sports uniform to school if they have a sports class for period 1 or wear it home if they have a sports class for period 4. Students may wear their sports uniform on Wednesdays. Classes that sports uniform can be worn include: Aquatic Practices, Recreation Studies, HPE (Junior Secondary). Students are required to wear their formal uniform Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and may wear it on Wednesday if they prefer not to wear the sport uniform.

Students must wear the complete day uniform or complete sports uniform (when applicable) in accordance with school routine. There is to be no mixing and matching of uniforms. Consistent breaches of the Uniform Code will result in disciplinary action as per the Student Code of Conduct.

### **Sports Excellence Uniform**

Sports Excellence Training Wear may only be worn for training purposes and can be purchased by students enrolled in the Sports Excellence Program. Students must not wear Sports Excellence training uniform in a class other than Sports Excellence, or on Wednesdays.

### **Winter Uniform - In cooler weather**

- Blue PBC jumper and/or the blue or red PBC jacket with PBC logo to be worn.
- Undershirts/t-shirts/singlets can be worn under the school shirt provided it cannot be seen. All undershirts are to be short sleeved and tucked in.
- PBC navy blue track pants, blue with white stripe and PBC logo. Track pants are not to be rolled up.

### **Hair/Hats**

- Hair styles and colour are to be appropriate to a professional work environment.
- Hair colour is to be of natural tone and no extreme styles or colours are permitted.
- Hair accessories should be navy or white. No scarves, headbands or beanies.
- Non-PBC hats are not acceptable at any time.

### **Make-up**

- No visible make-up or nail polish is to be worn.
- Sunscreen is encouraged to be worn that is of a natural tone.
- Eyelash extensions and/or acrylic nails are not to be worn.

### **Jewellery**

- Jewellery is optional and is restricted to a wrist watch.
- Earrings must be small and discreet. One earring in each ear only.
- Piercings: There are to be no visible facial piercings. They must be covered or clear. Other piercings and/or tattoos must not be visible.

### **Exam Shutdown**

The above Uniform Policy applies for all school periods, including Exam Shutdown for Senior Secondary students. Should a breach of the Uniform Policy occur during Shutdown without a note from home provided to the relevant Head of Year, behaviour management processes (including detentions) will apply.
