



- Helps if your studies have been negatively affected by circumstances outside of your control.
- Applies adjustment points to your rank to help you compete more equitably for an offer.
- Supporting documentation for applications will be required.



SCU Early Offer



- Open now, and applicable to all Year 12 school leavers.
- 65 yr 12 PBC students have applied already!
- Peace of mind with direct entry prior to the end of the year.
- No ATAR, no pre-requisite subjects required.
- Takes 5 minutes to do, you can do it tonight on your phone. See the team outside at the SCU table for help if you need it.



GU Early Offer



- Griffith University is also a popular destination for PBC graduates.
- Qualifications eligible include Cert 3, Cert 4, Diploma and ATAR.
- Adjustment factors for local area/subjects studied.
- Ask the Griffith Uni team outside for further information.


Key message

 A key message to take away – almost all Year 12 students are university eligible should they wish to pursue this path

- Qualifications include:
 - Entry to SCU via Early Offer Program
 - Tertiary entry to a range of Universities through Cert III, Cert IV, Diploma qualification
 - Tertiary entry through ATAR



- Griffith's VET & ATAR entry sheet highlights qualifications that universities recognise
- Most universities will produce a version of this document to assist with QTAC applications
