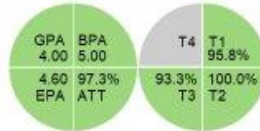
Year 12 Mentoring

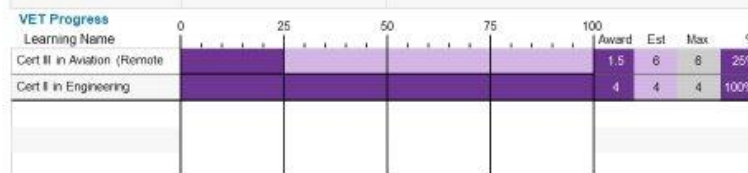

When you apply, QTAC will use your student information from individual QCAA accounts. This includes subject results, certificate and/or diploma courses.

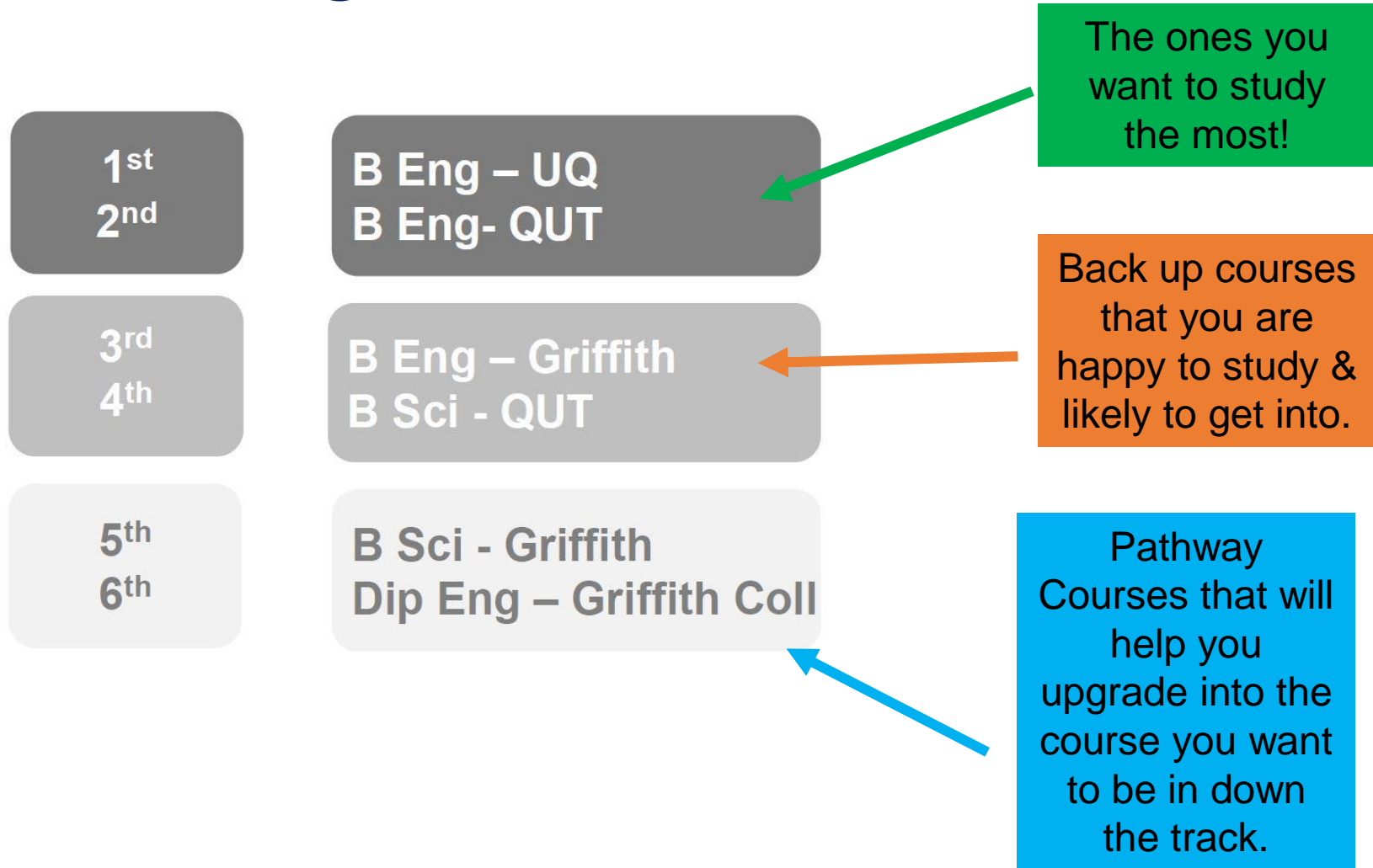

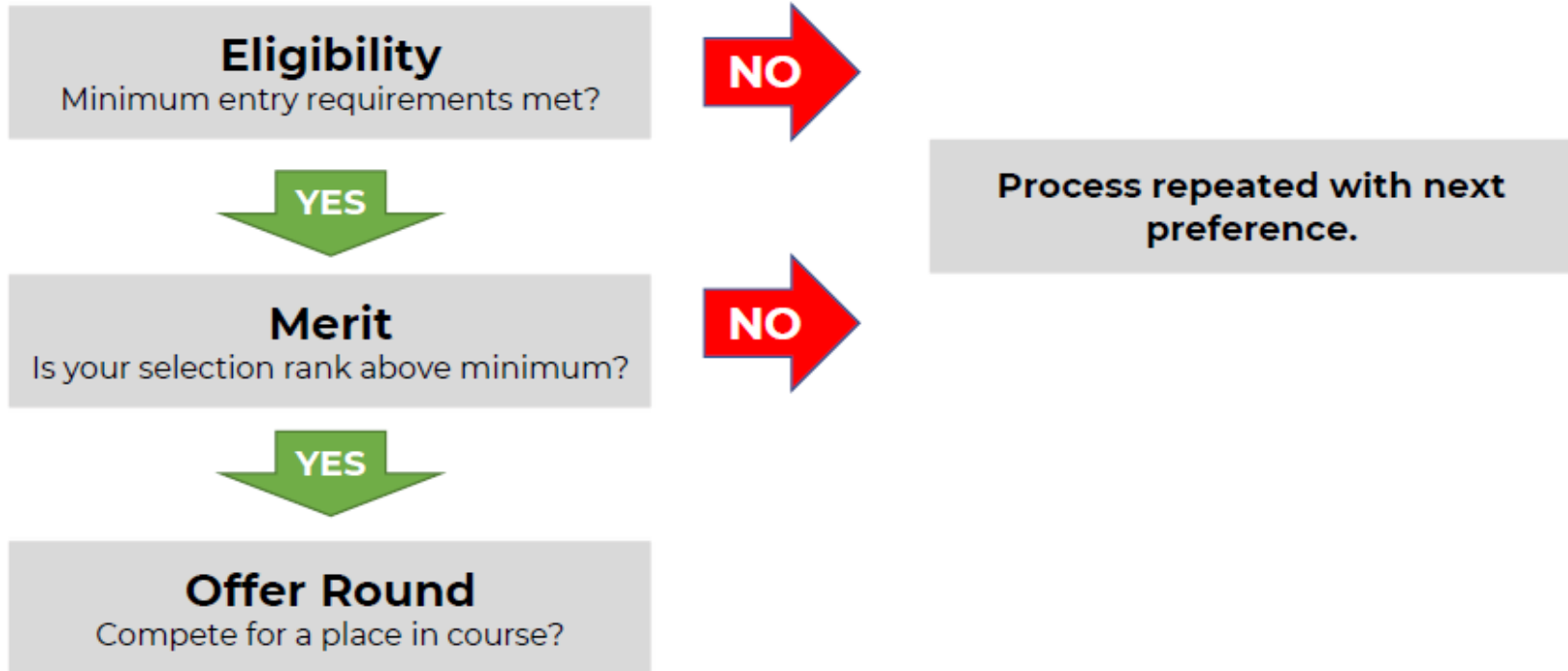
