




Year 12 Mentoring

Understanding your TrackEd Profile



GPA- Grade Point Average

BPA- Behaviour Point Average

EPA- Effort Point Average

- Point Averages are scored out of 5 & based on report grades A-E (5 is a perfect score & indicates all A's)
- ATT – Year to Date Attendance Percentage
- T1-T4 – Attendance Percentage per term


QCE

- S- Satisfactory = Passed unit
- U- Unsatisfactory = have not passed unit
- VET subjects will show at the bottom of your profile

ATAR

- General subjects numerical results completed and estimated final percentage
- At this point IA1 is the only assessment that has been assessed (subject to change based on confirmation)

*Note some subjects complete IA2 before IA1 (ENG & PED)



- This sections shows timetabled VET subjects and school based traineeships.
- Some providers award competencies throughout the course while others only upload upon final completion.
- This example shows 50% completion of the qualification which has been awarded and therefore the student has achieved 4 of the total 8 QCE points at this time.
- Cert 1-3 in school VET won't be showing yet, these points don't get banked until you finish.



QCE Points Awarded

- The final line tracking QCE will read ZERO for everyone.
- Keep in mind no matter how many points you've accumulated, nobody has a QCE until the end of year 12.
- The Senior School team tracks your progress to ensure you not only meet certain points, but complete core requirements.



Why should you track numerical marks?

- A-E grades provide a 5 point scale.
- % score provide a 100 point scale, therefore are a much more accurate indication of how you're going.
- If you are sitting below 50% in a subject, there is a risk that you will not pass. This risk needs to be managed.
- For the cohort at large, tracking your numerical grade allows you to set targets & measure growth.

Using ATAR Calculators

- ATAR calculators can be useful in setting goals, understanding the impact of scaling & testing reward for effort.
- Be warned... They assume that you will carry your grades consistently through to your final exam.

Consider things like the university, the course entry, the fees (!!), the graduation outcomes.

What is your current ATAR estimate?

What is your target % for each subject?

What support do you need to get there?
