



Academic Excellence Scholarships 2019 Criteria

Academic Excellence Scholarships will be awarded in all year levels to the highest achieving academic students. The scholarship entails the payment of Academic Excellence program fees and the School Resource Scheme levy.

Recipients will be selected in the following manner:

Scholarships for students entering Year 7 – based on the HAST entrance test and relevant entrance data submitted.

Scholarships for students entering Years 8, 9 and 10 – The following will be considered in determining scholarships:

- The student will be on the Principal's Honours List, having a Grade Point Average of 5 in each of the first 3 reporting periods of the year. (GPAs will be calculated on the core subjects studied at each year level. Rung of achievement in core subjects will be taken into consideration)
- Any external test results
 - ICAS – English, Maths and Science in years 7-10
 - NAPLAN achievement (if student is in a NAPLAN year)

Scholarships for students entering Years 11 and 12 - The following will be considered in determining scholarships:

- Grade Point Average calculated across all academic subjects studied. Performance-based or non-OP subjects are not counted in this calculation. (Rung of achievement and OP predictions for Year 11 students, will be taken into consideration)

In addition, a scholarship will be awarded to the highest achieving Indigenous student in each year level should they not be included in the above.
