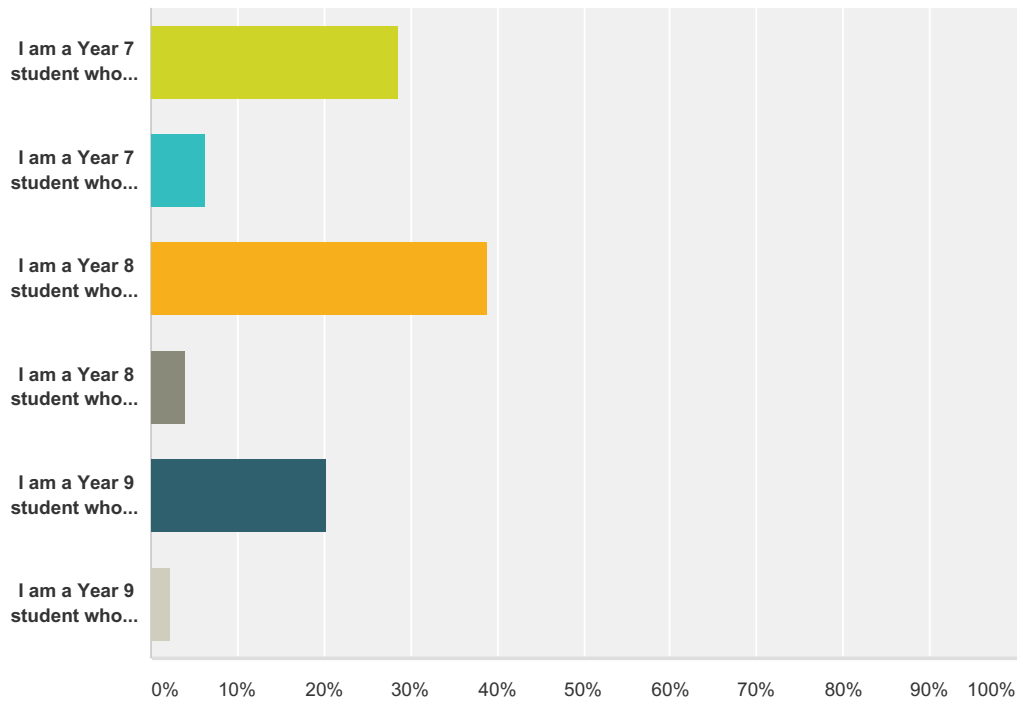


### Q1 Tick the statement that BEST describes you:

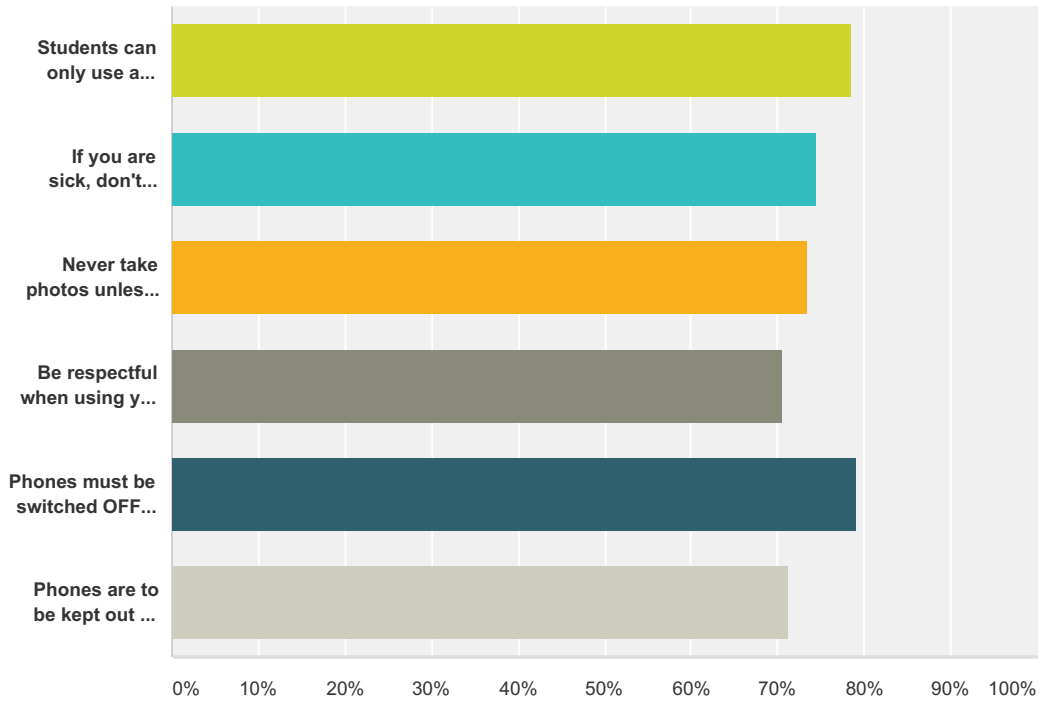

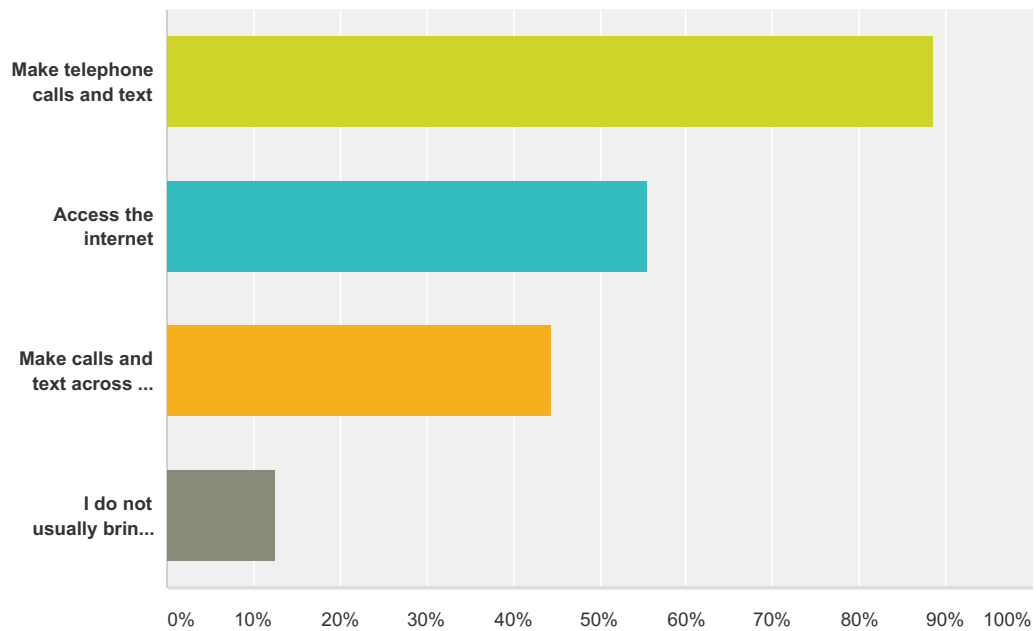

**Q3 If you usually bring a phone to school, what functions does it have? (Tick more than one if needed).**

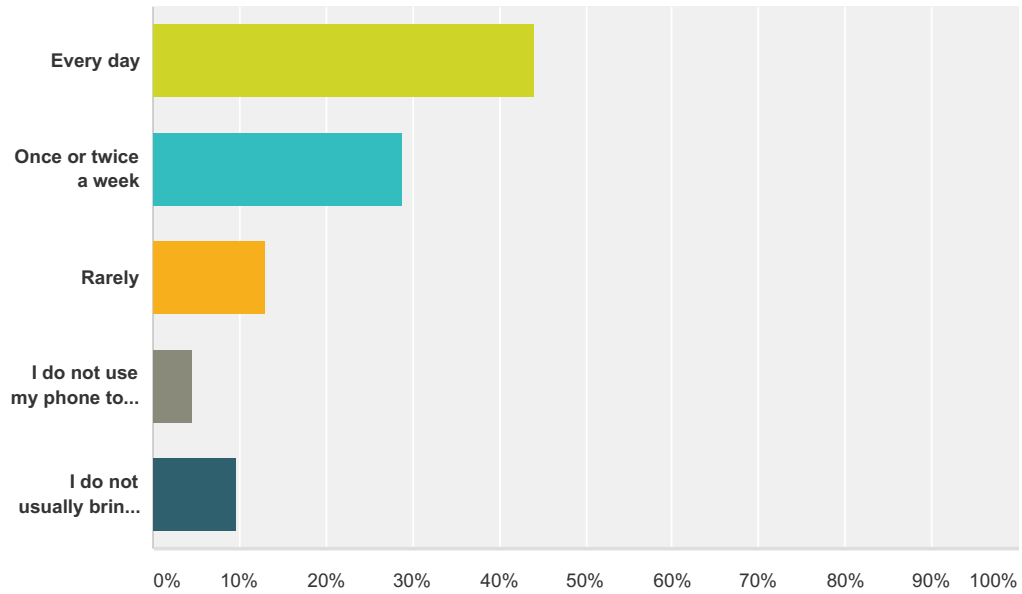

### Q4 When you are at school, how often do you usually communicate with your parents?

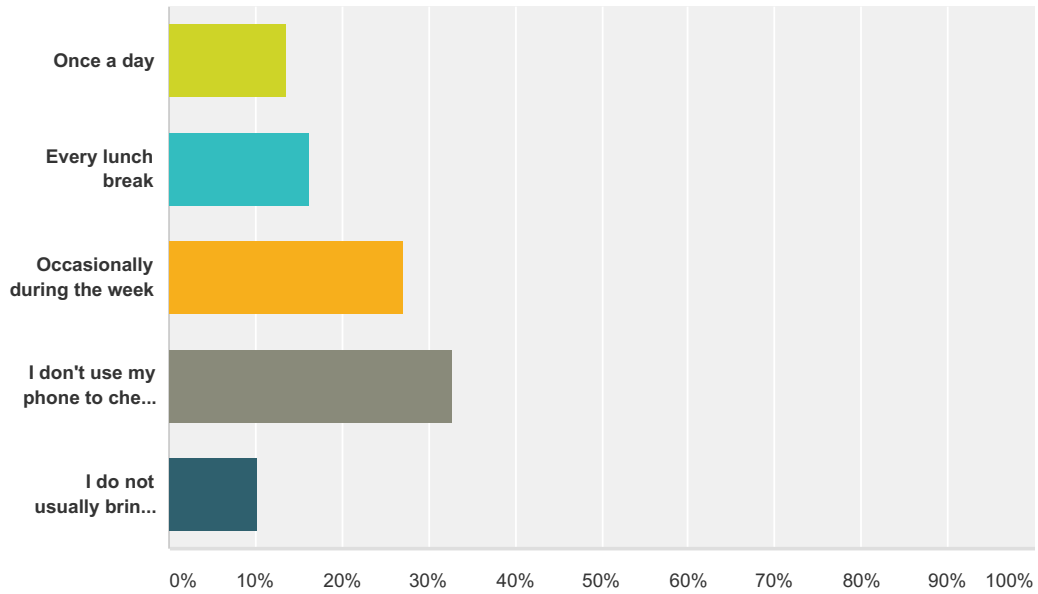

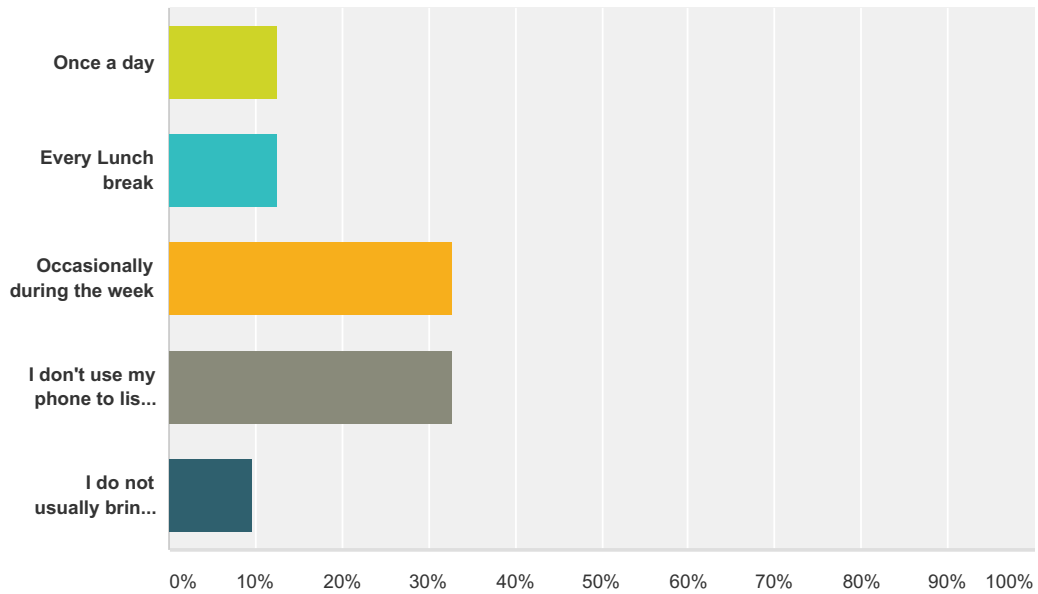

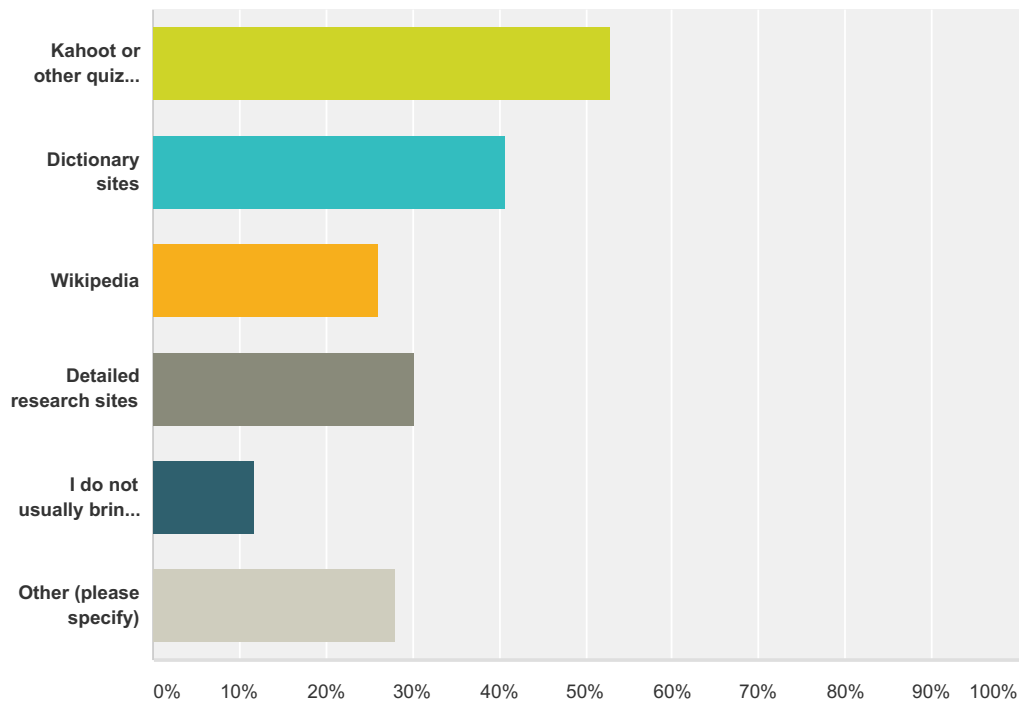

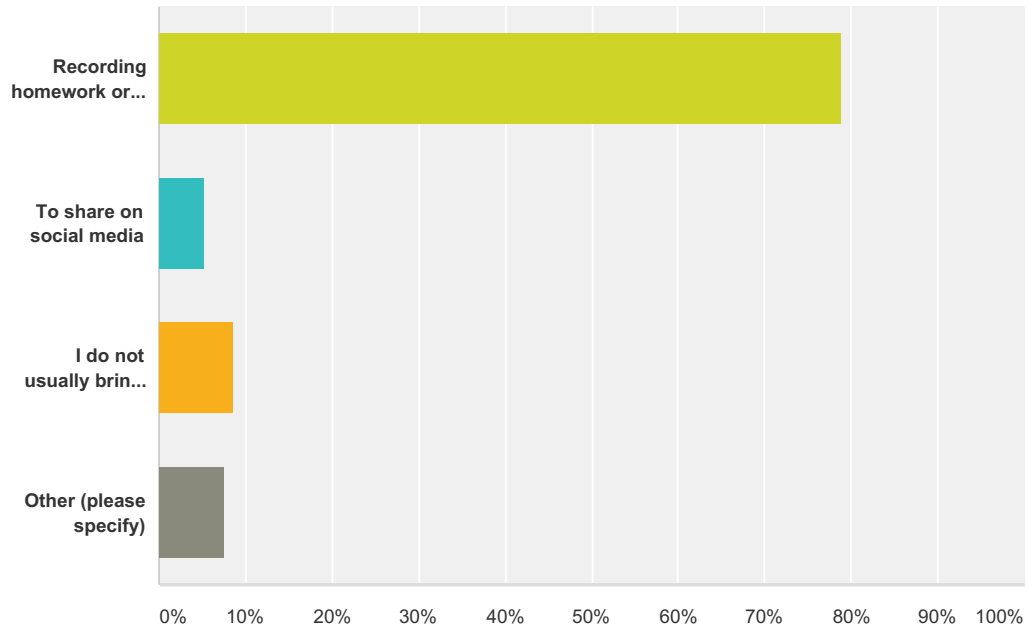

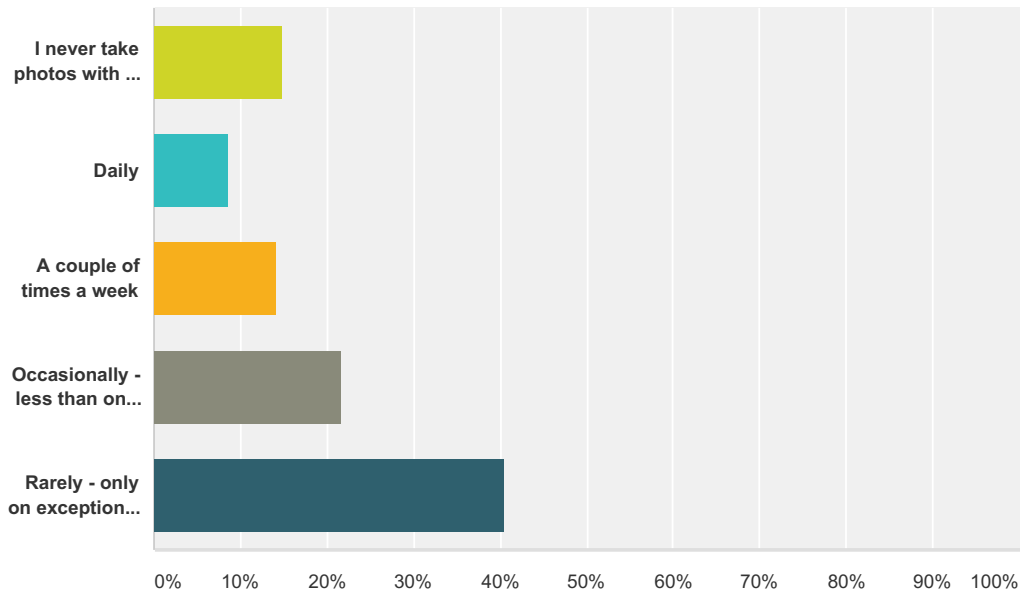

### Q9 How often do you use your phone to take photos at school?

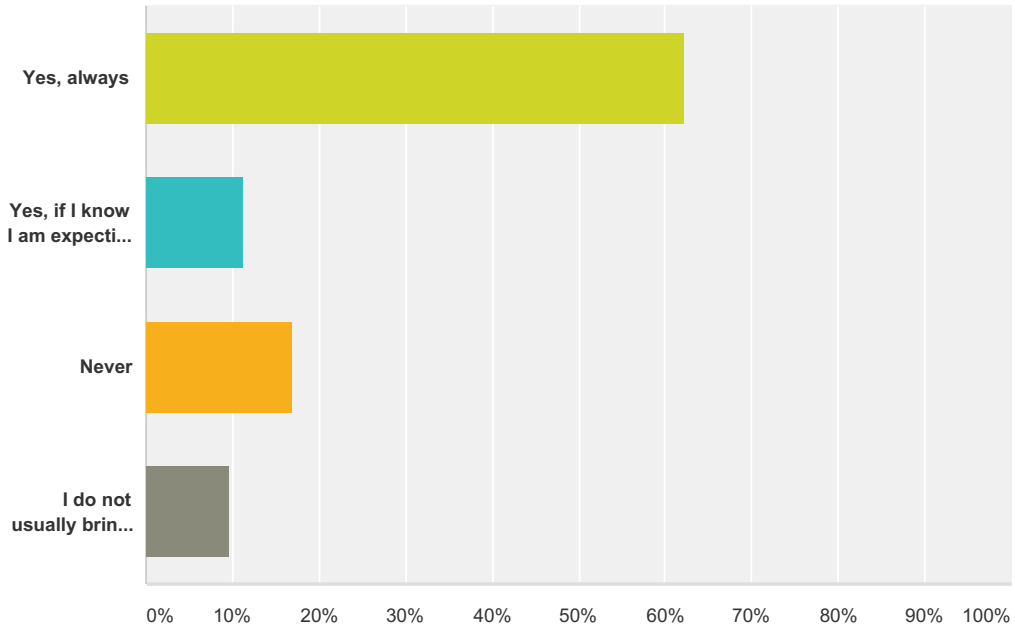

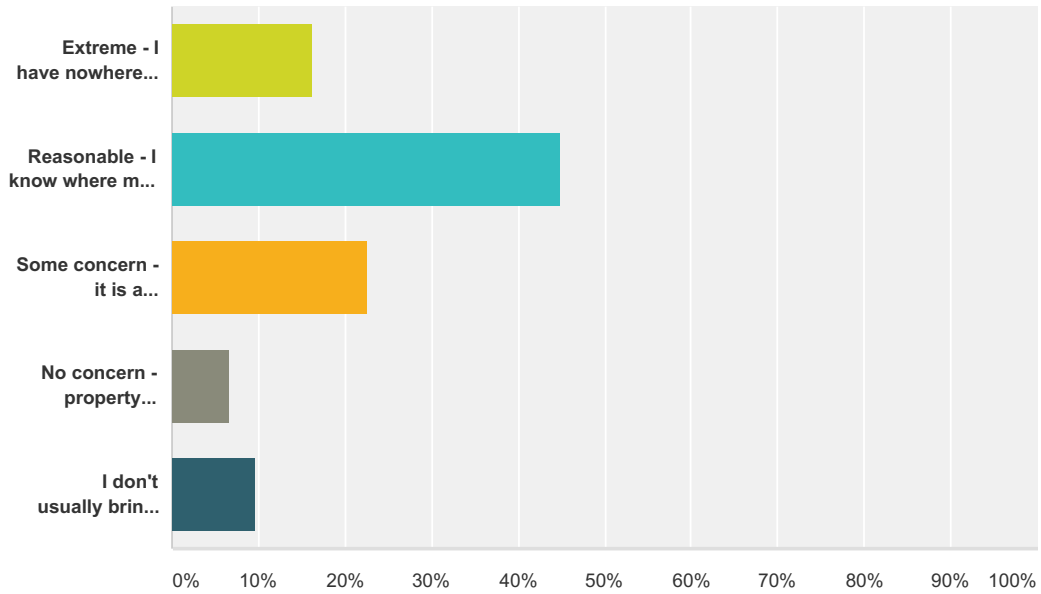

### Q11 What concern do you have for the safety or security of your phone while at school?

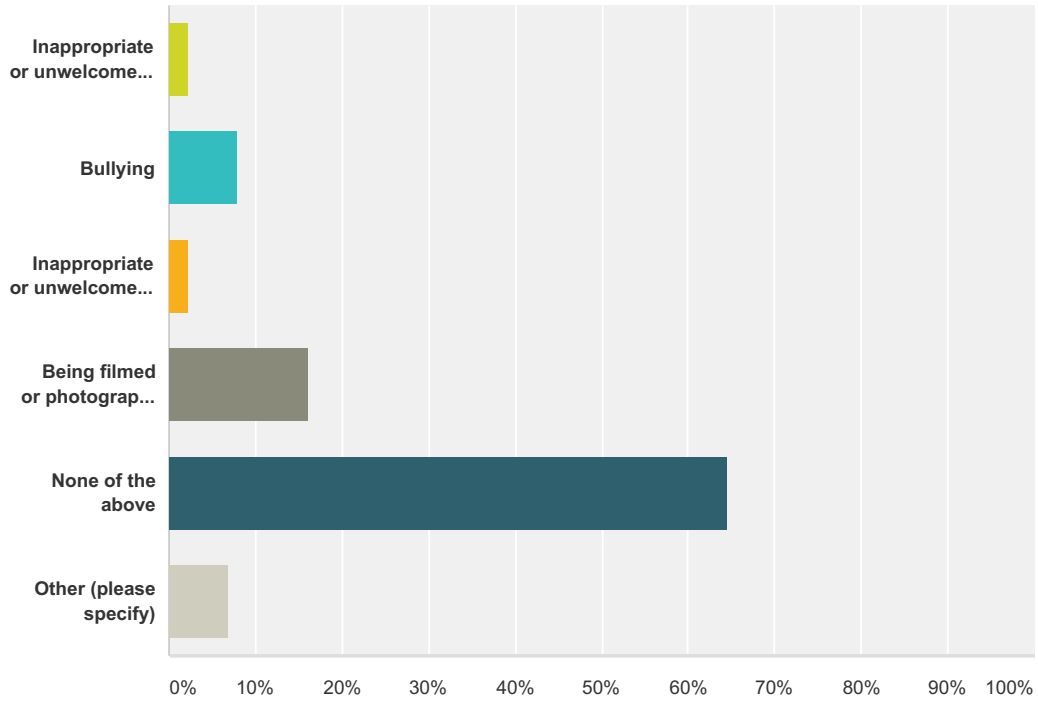

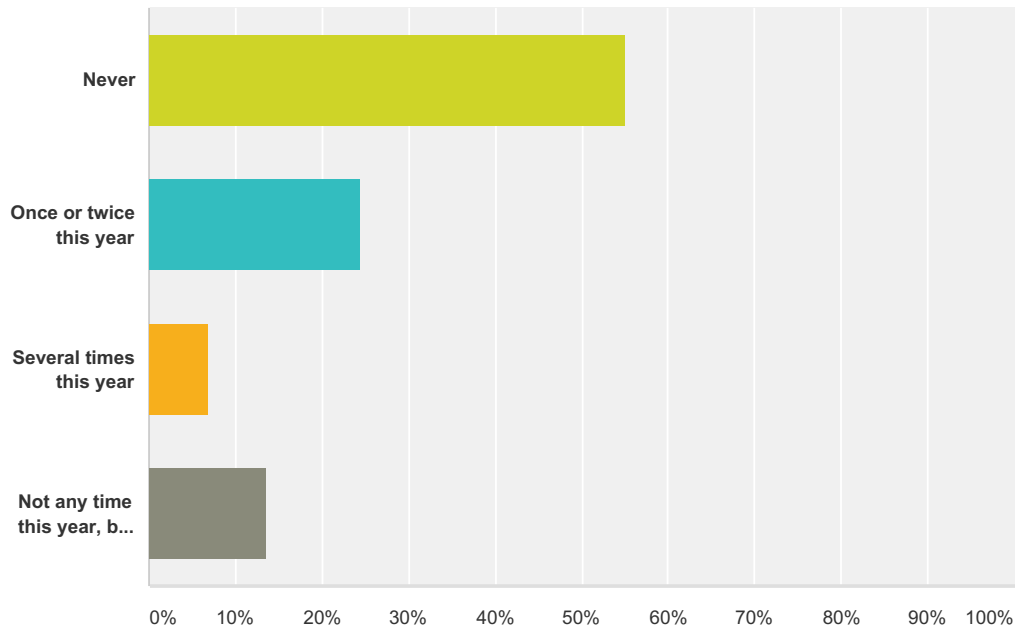

### Q13 How often have you had bad experiences because of mobile phones?

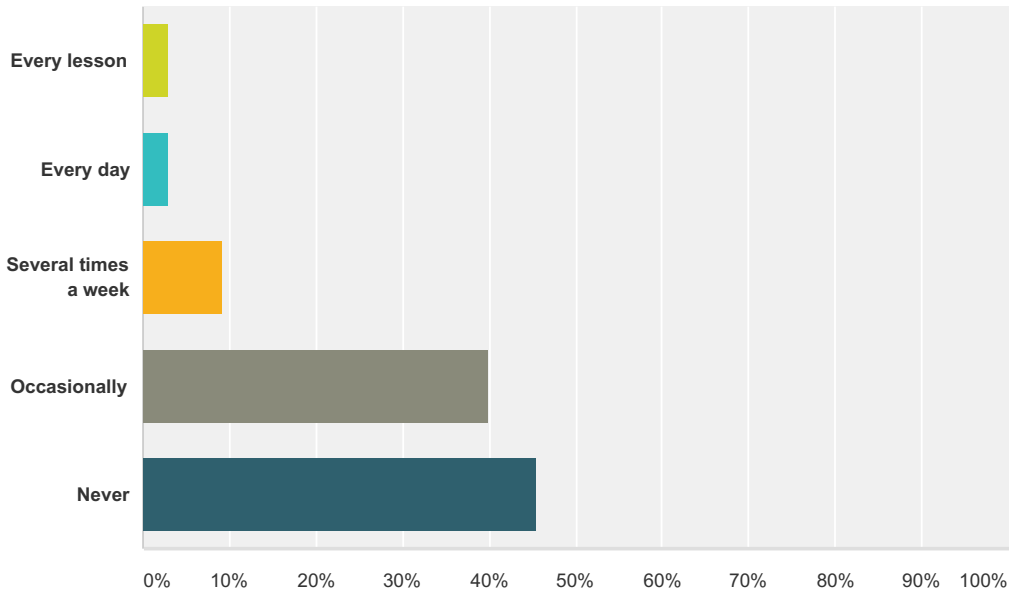

### Q14 How often does mobile phone misuse by students impact on your learning e.g. the teacher having to stop a lesson?

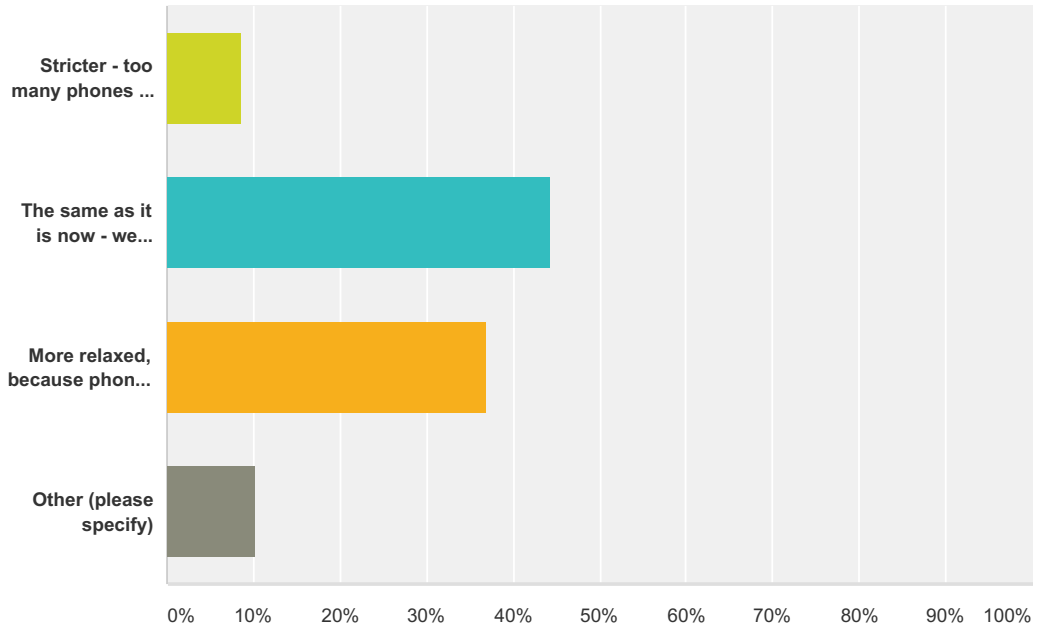

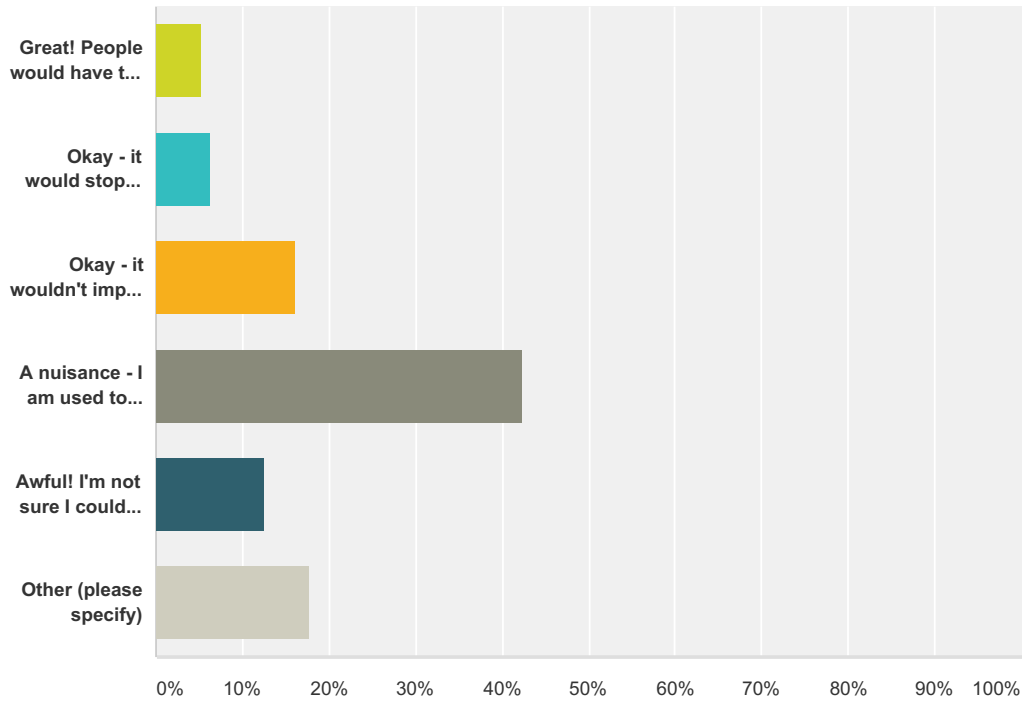
