



## Sports Awards Night Policy

### Rationale

#### Sports awards:

1. Recognise student/team achievement
2. Encourage and motivate students to achieve
3. Involve parents, school and wider community in recognition of student achievement
4. Recognise teacher/coach / school input
5. Expose students to elite sports role models

### Sports Awards Night Policy

1. Students engaged in school based sports competitions; i.e. PBC Excellence program, Queensland Secondary School Sports, or Australian school sports; will be eligible for awards at State (achievement) and National (Excellence) levels.
2. Students achieving State or National status in the above sports, conducted by the official State or National Association will also be recognised with achievement and excellence awards.
3. Students engaged in Open Senior Men's/Women's competition in the above sports will have their achievements considered in Sports Awards of the Year deliberations.

### Sports Awards Levels

#### 1. Achievement Awards

- a) Students selected in State Representative Teams
- b) Students finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> in State Championships (E.g. Track and Field)

#### 2. Excellence Awards

- a) Students selected in National State Representative Teams
- b) Students finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> in National Championships (E.g. Track and Field)

### Champion Team Awards

1. **Achievement:** PBC Teams placing 1<sup>st</sup> in Queensland Secondary School Sports
2. **Excellence:** PBC teams placing 1<sup>st</sup> in Australia Secondary School Sports

### Reds Awards

The student who best represents the attitude, values and achievement of each particular Sports Excellence program.

### Sports Awards of the Year

A panel of three coaches, a HOD and the Executive Principal will determine:

1. **Senior Sports Awards of the Year:** Male and female, 16 years and above age group
2. **Junior Sports Awards of the Year:** Male and female, 12–15 years age group

### Criteria

1. Level of sport achievement: QSSS and senior competitions considered
2. Variety of representations
3. Attitude, example etc.
