Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2017, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2017 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Improve PBC's National Minimum Standard Scores to above National Benchmarks in four domains of NAPLAN testing.
- Implementing specific intervention strategies for identified target student groups e.g. Academic Excellence Students, PBC Literacy and Numeracy Program (LAN) and Quicksmart Literacy and Numeracy for identified learning support students.
- Implement a Literacy Program containing explicit literacy bites embedded within the Middle School English program across 7 – 9 to improve NAPLAN reading, spelling, language conventions and writing domains.

Our school initiatives are showing substantial progress toward our targets

After reviewing our 2017 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our initiatives as needed to ensure every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Build a culture that promotes learning through effective student management and recognition and acknowledgment of positive behaviour choices by students.
- Collecting relevant and specific data to assess students' current performance, comprehensive analysis of data to determine the specific and targeted strategies required.
- Data analysis and implementing specific strategies to promote student learning through attendance, intervention and implement a new pastoral care program.
