TALK THE TALK

- **QCE** - QLD Certificate of Education
- Year 11 and 12 are completed in **UNITS not TERMS**. Be aware of assessment times.
- **ATAR/GENERAL** - Academically rigorous subjects, uni entry score requirement.
- **APPLIED** - Less theory, practical & skills based. Still assessed with exams etc.
- **VET** - Vocational Education and Training, employment focused, has a qualification.
- **PATHWAY** - Direction of study ATAR or PERSONALISED.
- **ATAR** - At least 5 general subjects, aiming for a uni entry score.
- **PERSONALISED** - Combination of subject types, 1 VET subject is recommended.
- **VETis** - Fully funded VET courses in schools. Run on the timetable. 1 per student.
- **FEE FOR SERVICE** - Out of pocket VET course subjects, run on the timetable.
- **EXTERNAL VETis** - Delivered by external provider, one day per week off campus + 6
- **SCHOOL BASED TRAINEESHIP** - 1 to 2 years duration, 1 day off campus + 6 subjects
- **SCHOOL BASED APPRENTICESHIP** - one day off campus + 6 subjects

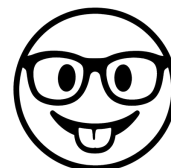
